2017 Trenton Murder Investigation Seeking Answers

A family still feels the loss of a man who meant the world to them. Danny Lamor Greene and his wife were in the process of moving into their home on Dragon Lair Road in Trenton. A quiet rural road, not far from the hustle of one of the largest tire manufactures located Graniteville, SC. The early evening of January 17, 2017, a family was forever changed when a 911 call reported the discovery of a dead body. Just before 5:58 pm, Danny was found outside lying on the ground motionless by a family friend. After the scene was secured by deputies, the Aiken County EMS pronounced Mr. Greene dead on scene. The Aiken County Coroner Darryl Ables (formerly Chief wounds to his body. The home that Danny and his wife were preparing to live in sustained damage to the side door, appearing that the door was kicked in.



Investigators searched the home, the yard and surrounding area for clues in this investigation. It has been 4 years since the discovery of Mr. Greene. A family continues to hold onto hope that someone with some information could lead to finding justice for Danny but also a community that has been affected by his unjustly passing. It takes a community to be a Voice for the Voiceless. No investigation is complete without community support.
